The City of Van Buren Civil Service Commission is currently accepting applications for the position of Police & Fire Dispatcher. Applicants must be a US Citizen, a minimum of 21 years of age, free of any felony record, possess a high school diploma or GED and a valid driver's license. Vision may be no worse than 20/100 correctable to 20/20. Prior dispatcher experience is not required.

Starting pay during probation is \$29,235.73 annually, plus medical, dental, vision, life and retirement benefits. Upon completion of one-year probation and training, annual pay will be \$30,899.15, plus additional step raises and incentives.

Applications may be picked up at the Van Buren Police Department Information Desk, Monday thru Friday, between 8:00am and 4:30pm, 800 Fayetteville Road, Van Buren, AR or by calling (479) 471-5022. Only application packets provided by the Van Buren Police Department will be accepted. Emailed resumes will not be accepted.

Applications will not be accepted after 2:00pm, September 29, 2017. Date of the written examination will be October 2, 2017, at 6:00 pm in the Van Buren Police Department Training Center, 800 Fayetteville Road.

Upon successfully passing the written Civil Service Examination, applicants will be required to successfully pass a multi-task skills exam, background investigation, police review board, a drug screen and physical exam by a doctor.

There will be no makeup day for the written examination.

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
