The City of Van Buren Police Department is currently accepting applications for the position of Police Officer. Applicants must be a US Citizen with no disqualifying convictions, possess a high school diploma or GED and a valid driver's license. Vision may be no worse than 20/100 correctible to 20/20. Applicants must be at least 21 years of age at the time of hire.

Starting pay is \$33,766.00 annually plus medical, dental, vision, life and retirement benefits. Upon completion of one-year probation and certification, annual pay will be \$35,372.62 plus incentives. Upon completion of all six step raises for police officer, annual pay will be \$37,782.92.

Applications may be picked up at the Van Buren Police Department Information Desk, located at 800 Fayetteville Road, Van Buren, AR. Applications can only be turned back in, in person, at the Van Buren Police Department. Applications, resumes, etc. will not be accepted electronically.

Applications will not be accepted after 4:00 pm on Friday, April 17, 2020. Date of the written examination will be Monday, April 20, 2020 at 6:00pm, at the Van Buren Police Department Training Center, 800 Fayetteville Road, Van Buren, AR.

Applicants will be required to successfully complete the physical agility test. The physical agility test will be given on Monday, April 20, 2020 at 12:00 pm at Blakemore Field, 2202 Alma Boulevard, Van Buren, AR.

Upon successfully passing the written Civil Service Examination and the physical agility test, applicants will be required to successfully pass an extensive background investigation and police review board.

There will not be a makeup day for the written examination.
There will not be a makeup day for the physical agility test.
